#### President (Vacant)

• No update was given for the SEPH School Assembly

### Vice President

- The October meeting of the Faculty of Medicine Graduate Studies Council was cancelled
- The Faculty of Medicine Faculty Council mainly focused on strategic priorities for the Faculty
  - The Dean noted during his report that the university has found itself in a \$74M deficit this year (down from a \$41M surplus last year)
    - Primary driver was stock market losses, but expect to see further cutbacks and belt tightening around the University
  - The Dean would like to leverage the changing mayor to expand our integration with municipal services. Amongst other things this may mean more research and placement opportunities with the City of Ottawa

### Vice President, Epidemiology Academic Affairs

- No SEPH Epidemiologγ Graduate Studies Council has been held since our last meeting
  - Minimum stipend increased to \$18,000 (MSc) and \$21,000 (PhD) at the recommendation of the external evaluator for the epidemiology programs (\$7,500 provided by uOttawa in year one)
    - Charles would like input on whether incoming students should be allowed to waive the scholarship and self-fund their studies. Currentlγ students require a supervisor to provide funding in order to enter the program
- No SEPH Program Development Committee has been held since our last meeting
- Shan is Planning a Scholarship Application session Tuesdaγ 8 November (CIHR, OGS, QE-II)
- Shan is working with Ian Colman to plan a Research Paper vs Thesis discussion session
