Scholarship Changes

- MSc Admissions Scholarship
 - Charles has followed up with Alain Stintzi (FoM Vice-Dean Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies)
 - Changing to \$6,000 and allocated to most students with an 8.0GPA or higher for 1 γear
 - International students and research-project based MSc students not included

- SEPH is planning to increase minimum stipend funding as a result of the Accreditation Report to be in line with other programs at the FoM (\$19,000)
- Charles is still trying to schedule a meeting with Claire Turenne Sjolander (Vice-Provost Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies) on this issue
- We will need to re-write the <u>SEPHGSA funding blog</u> to address these changes
